7¹/₄" Proficiency Award Scheme

How the scheme operates.

When an organization wishes to take part in the scheme a 7¹/₄" Gauge Society member belonging to that organization is appointed by the organization as their representative and assessor (more than one assessor can be appointed). The name/s would be registered with the 7¹/₄" Gauge Society Ltd.

The scheme documentation necessary to be able to operate the scheme at club/organization level will be available from the Seven and a Quarter Website, with the exception of the assessor's pack.

The pack contains

- 1) Bronze Test papers
- 2) Silver Test papers
- 3) Adjudicators guidance Booklet
- 4) Return Address envelopes

Candidates taking Part

The candidates will have a series of guidance PDF format documents to study which will enable them, with perhaps guidance from club members, to achieve the desired award. There is no time limit as to how long the candidate requires before the test is carried out. It is entirely dependent on the participant's level of experience and knowledge.

After testing a candidate for either the Bronze or Silver award the assessor sends a copy of the applicant's test paper to the Scheme Co-Ordinator, who will send a congratulatory letter to the successful candidate. A certificate will be sent to the adjudicator for them to present to the candidate

Applicants for the Gold award must fill out an application form, which the club representative sends to the scheme Co-Ordinator, who will register the applicant and notify them when training/testing events are available to progress their Gold Award.

Applicants for the Gold and Silver awards must be members of both the 7¹/₄" Gauge Society Ltd and the participating organization.

All the administrative costs are borne by the 7¹/₄" Gauge Society Ltd., who also supply the core paperwork for the organization to successfully run the scheme.
